All rams and gimmers have been videoed and commentary has been provided by either Rod or Emily, thank you to them for assisting with this, its not only shared the workload but its given a different perspective and they will no doubt see things, that those of us that see the sheep day in day out, don't.

Finally a few thank you's. Our sponsors have been awesome, they have embraced change and haven't hesitated when asked to support us again this year.

Our team at Fearn have worked extremely hard to make this event

Ram Health

All our rams produced by our stud flock are MV accredited and as per usual all rams are in the Heptivac-P+ system, and have been injected with Cydection 2% LA solution and Zolvix on the day of the sale so they are ready to enter your quarantine facilities when they arrive at your farms.

We have also vaccinated all rams with Bravoxin 10 bringing us in line with the rams that Innovis sell in other areas, this will give added cover against pneumonia. If you have any questions regarding our treatments please speak to a member of the team.

Sale Day

Between 2pm and 3pm sale day we will have a live stream and also a live chat function available via the bidding portal, to allow for buyers to request to see certain lots and ask any questions which they may have. This will also allow those not able to attend on the day an opportunity to get the feel of the sale from a distance and hopefully in years to come we will be able to return to hosting our normal social gathering whilst possibly retaining this sale format if it goes well?



Bidding

- Representatives of Dingwall & Highland Marts will also be on hand to accept bids if you are uncomfortable using the system.
- Sale concludes at 3pm 28/08/20 when there has been a clear 2 minute period without any bids.
- If a bid is placed on any lot during that 2-minute period then bidding on all lots is extended for a further 2 minutes.
- The extended bidding period may shorten to 1 min if required and final time will be called clearly by the auctioneer who will use their discretion to ensure all bidders are satisfied.

Collection & Delivery

We will work with buyers to ensure rams get delivered as soon as possible after the sale, we can deliver locally at no charge and will work with hauliers to arrange delivery further afield. Collection will be available for those present on the day once the sale has concluded on Friday 28th August 2020.

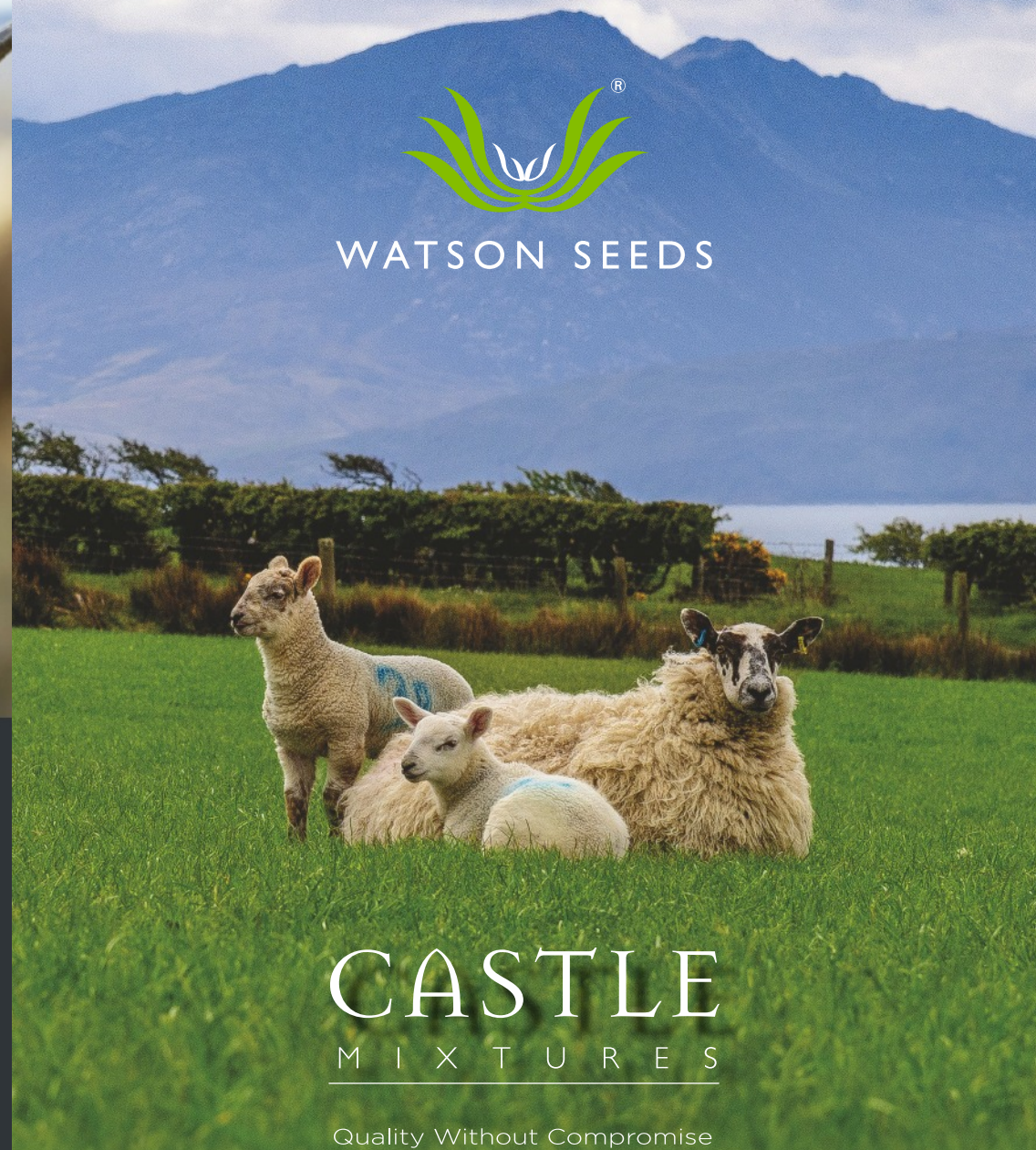



Our gimmers have been bred on the same principles as our rams, they are on the Heptivac P plus system and have been vaccinated with Enzovax and Toxovax. If you have any questions about them or would like assistance choosing the right breed and combination for you and your farm or croft please don't hesitate to ask.

Suffolk X Females

One of the great things about the NZ Suffolk is that it produces excellent females, when used over Aberfield cross ewes it gives a long feminine ewe which when crossed back with a beltex of Suffolk will give a cracking prime lamb.

Aberfield X Females

Most of our crossbred ewes at Fearn now have a degree of Aberfield in them, we find they suit the farm, have a nice number of lambs and are extremely maternal. We cross them with the New Zealand Suffolk to produce prime lambs and ewe lambs for selling as gimmers.

Cheviot Females

We don't have many cheviot ewes and to be honest they maybe just complicate our system therefore we offer for sale all of our gimmers this year.

They cross well with many breeds of ram but my own personal preference would be to use an Aberfield or NZ Suffolk over them which would produce a female to retain along with a wedder lamb which is easily finished.
